Spend time writing a list of the 10 best things that happened this year! What were their favorite things they did, learned, or experienced?

Give youth something to look forward to in the new year, practice writing SMART goals: specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, and time-measured!



THE NEW YEAR

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Give youth time to honor the difficult parts of the year.

Ask youth what was a challenge they faced that year and what they did that helped them get through it. Celebrate overcoming and working through struggles.

Work with youth to plan a hoppy way to finish out the semester. What is someting you all could do together to celebrate the end of year and all they learned?
